~ We have a major answered prayer! Here are some excerpts from past prayer letters:

[August]...Recently the downstairs of my parents' house flooded with sewage (This is where my wife and I live). The floors need to be completely repaired. My parents are dealing with the insurance company. Please pray that they

cover as much of the repairs as possible...[September] The city has begun repairing the piping outside my parents' house, but there are still unresolved issues. The damage done to their home was a result of the city's faulty piping and drainage. A government staffer advised them to contact the city's insurance company due to the fault lying with the city. My parents have since contacted them; three times, the city's insurance company has refused the claim...It would be quite a miracle for those in power to take responsibility, show compassion for the need, and help my parents. However, we serve an awesome God. Please pray that God would guide my parents as they work to repair the house.



God answers prayers! The Bible says, "The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will" (Proverbs 21:1). God moved the hearts of those in authority; the insurance company has caved. They have agreed to cover the cost of the damage caused by the city's faulty pipes. While there are still details to be worked out with the insurance company, it is worth noting God's goodness toward us. Thank you to all of those who prayed for this situation.

~ We are home! It was wonderful to meet such kind Christians in the U.S., but we are very happy to be back in Iceland. It has been wonderful to jump into the ministry and fellowship with our sweet church plant. (I am so proud of them.) Beyond returning home, we are waiting to see where our support level currently sits. Thankfully, several churches have promised and voted to take us on for support; and we are incredibly grateful. That said, we will not have a concrete idea of our support level until all the funds begin to arrive. My hope is that by the end of November, I will have a better idea of where we stand. Whatever our support, Phyllis and I are planning to visit the U.S. next year for September, October, and November. (Until Phyllis is granted a permanent visa, we are limited to 3 months of U.S. travel.) Although the situation is complex, we do not want to make excuses. Proverbs 22:13 says, "The slothful man saith, There is a lion without, I shall be slain in the streets." Rather than doing nothing because of difficulties, we are trying to make best use of the situation God has laid before us. Please pray that God would use us whatever our support level and through these immigration circumstances.
