Grandparents expect it [i.e., confirmation in the Lutheran church]. Families fear being seen as different if their children do not participate. This is often the first



test where societal pressure begins to shape a teenager's choices, and sadly, many begin to drift away from church soon after. However, by God's grace, one of our teenagers has made the bold decision to be baptized instead of confirmed! This is a significant step of faith, but the pressure is overwhelming. Please pray that this teenager stands strong in their decision and that their example will inspire others to truly follow Christ – not tradition.

We have good news! In defiance of culture and tradition, and while wearing a sweater with the printed phrase "Jesus Saves," this teenager chose to follow Jesus' example and be baptized. Many of her extended family members refused to attend her celebration in protest, as it would be embarrassing to attend our church – the Baptist church. While they were ashamed, we are so proud of her. To those who prayed, please rejoice with us that one more person has chosen to follow Jesus.
