Teen Church



Bus Ministry

In fact, he practiced managing the "classroom" by teaching his lessons to me while I pretended to be a child. We did this for a few weeks until he became more confident. Slowly, he began taking increased responsibility while my influence was reduced to supporting from the background. Since then, he has faithfully taught my former classroom about Jesus, but not alone. Upon my return to Iceland in 2023/2024, John became engaged to Faith. She had been attending church and helping with our children's ministry for several years in a myriad of ways. When they got married, Faith jumped in and became his helper. Together, they have been sharing God's love through our bus ministry. It is incredibly encouraging to teach my former group and see how John and Faith have invested in these children. Please praise God with me that we are not alone in our attempt to reach the people of Iceland with the gospel.
