Sponsor a Bus Kid?

~ June 22-27 is the official starting date for our summer camp outreach. With the regular bus ministry, we get only a few hours a week to influence these children for Jesus. Summer camp, on the other hand, is an opportunity to bring these children out of worldly influences for a whole week! In our experience, most of the decisions to trust Christ take place during summer camp.



Members of our church take that week off (often as unpaid vacation) to work as unpaid volunteers and reach these children for Christ. Furthermore, we do not charge the children for coming to camp. As a result, it is only by the generosity of fellow Christians (from the U.S.) that we can afford this endeavor. Essentially, we in Iceland are willing to put in the work and give what we can, but we need help to afford the whole project. If you feel that this outreach program is a worthy cause, would you consider helping us? It costs approximately \$250 to sponsor one child for camp. When John the Baptist was ministering, the Bible teaches that part of his calling comes from Malachi 4:5-6, "...he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children..." In Iceland, there are many fathers (parents) who do not value God, the Bible, and Jesus. These parents do not have their hearts turned toward their children in relation to faith. If they will not turn their hearts to the children, we will. We will tell these children that they have a heavenly Father whose heart is always turned to them, a heavenly Father who desperately wants a relationship with them. Please pray with use as we plan to turn our hearts to the children of Iceland and share the love of Christ through our summer outreach program.

Baptism Sunday



~ A few months ago, a couple called asking for information about our church. My father answered their questions and encouraged them to stop by and visit us on a weekday. The couple did visit and started attending our services. The man had a profession of faith in Christ, and wanted to be baptized. After ensuring he fully understood the gospel and baptism, we scheduled it. The Icelandic woman, on the other hand, was not as familiar with Christianity. However, she continued to attend and hear the gospel. Eventually,

The Icelandic woman began asking about baptism, but there were scheduling conflicts. My parents ended up leaving for the U.S. before she could be baptized. This all crescendoed with her asking me if we could baptize her the following Sunday. We marked it down and baptized her on March 22. Praise God that more people are choosing to trust Christ and follow His example in believers' baptism. Please pray that this couple would continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus.
