Discipleship

~ For the past several weeks, I have had the honor of discipling a young man who was recently baptized at our church. It began about five or six weeks ago when this 19-year-old started showing a desire to help, whether throughout the week or on Sundays. I then explained that we needed to talk before moving forward. (This is what sparked our weekly discipleship.) He and I began meeting every Thursday, one hour before our midweek service. First, I emphasized salvation, and he expressed his confidence and faith in Jesus. Second, we discussed baptism, and, soon after, he was baptized. Finally, we reviewed two aspects of church membership: 1) Biblical church membership 2) Our church guidelines and policies for becoming a member and volunteer. A couple of weeks later, he expressed interest in becoming an official member of the church. Our church voted and welcomed him into membership. Now we are slowly integrating him into our ministries, continuing weekly discipleship, and trying to help him uncover the gifts God has given him for ministry. Please pray that this young man – Alberto – would continue to have a tender heart, a desire to serve, and a hunger to understand God’s Word.
