However, Godwind also said that he needed to attend church more regularly, start helping and serving at church, and get baptized. After summer camp, he was baptized. As of the writing of this letter, he has continued to attend and has started helping my wife teach our kindergarten bus kids about Jesus. He is not the only teenager who has been attending and helping regularly since summer camp. Two other teenagers who have regularly attended our teen service have begun attending on Sundays as well to help with the children. I am so encouraged by these young men choosing Jesus. That said, they still live in Iceland where obeying Christ and Scripture is looked upon as peculiar. People will tell them they are crazy and weird for choosing Jesus, especially at our church. Please pray that the change we have seen in these teenagers would not be short-term summer-camp excitement but would develop into a lasting choice to live for Jesus.



## Baby Samuel

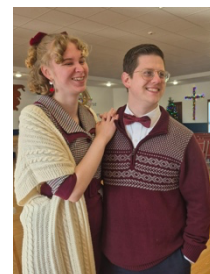
