~ It has been a wild month! At the beginning of June, my parents arrived back home. We are so excited to have them back. With their return, several major events were kicked into high gear, mainly summer camp. The entire beginning of this month was spent preparing the building and property for this outreach. Furthermore, we reached out to the parents of those children planning to attend to confirm our final number of campers. There were several Icelandic speaking children who we really wanted to attend, but they had been hesitant to commit. Finally, at the last hour, they let us know they would be coming. In summary, with my parents' return, we began the final stages of preparation for summer camp.



Summer Camp

~ Several of our supporters sent funds for this specific outreach, and I want to give a thorough explanation of what took place. We had 25 campers and approximately the same amount of camp staffers. We split into four teams – red, yellow, blue, and green. I was the team leader (camp counselor) for the yellow team.

As the week progressed, God began to work in the hearts of the children on our teams. Each of the 25 campers was given a chance to speak directly with my parents. Eight of those children made professions of faith in Christ. Several more made commitments to avoid worldly lusts such as alcohol, vaping, drugs, etc. Some even committed to future morality – e.g., committing to be a good mom or faithfully attend church. In the cold spiritual state that is Iceland, it is a blessing to place these children in a godly environment and allow God to work. We have been preparing their hearts (in some cases for years) and this camp allowed us the opportunity to reap the spiritual benefits of that consistent teaching, prayer, etc. While we are so grateful for this opportunity, most of these children are going back to homes where their parents are not serving Jesus. Please pray that God would help the little faith that has just been planted to grow and not be choked by thorns or withered by a field of rocks.
