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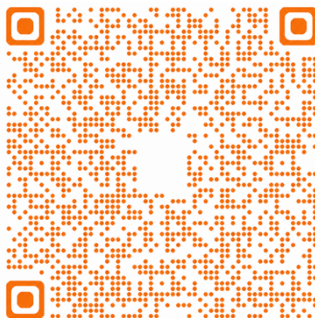
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Operation Fiery Furnace

~ This month we worked and operated as property repairmen. My father spent many hours and days painting one-third of the church roof. While he worked on the roof, a fellow missionary (Nathan Sears), oiled the exterior wood of the building, protecting it from future decay. Two classrooms needed major repairs (mudding, painting, etc.), particularly following summer camp. Thankfully, we decided to take two weeks off from our bus ministry, and this allowed me to make those necessary repairs. Furthermore, the fire inspector came and gave us some requirements to bring the building completely up to fire code. As a result, we have a new goal: **Operation Fiery Furnace**. To make the building more fire-safe, we need to purchase and install two fire doors. The cost for this project is ~\$5000 per door. Please pray for us as we begin saving and planning for this project.
